Is there a program online?

Yes, programs will be available online at www.waopera.asn.au closer to the event.

What time does the performance start?

The Performance will commence at 6.30pm

What time does the performance finish?

The Performance will conclude at 8.00pm

Will there be an interval?

Yes, there will be one 30 minute interval.

What happens if it rains or is windy?

We try our best to persevere in rain or wind however if the situation is dangerous or uncomfortable for patrons and performers the concert may be cancelled (and cannot be rescheduled). If we are able to continue with the performance please note that the quality of the sound may be affected. Please bring a raincoat if rain is forecast

Do I need to bring a chair?

Yes, you are required to bring your own chair. There will be dedicated blanket, low chair and high chair area.

What do I wear?

The event is casual, please dress comfortably. The weather is cooler in the evening so we recommend a jacket.

Yes, the café at the Ningaloo Centre will be open.

What do I bring?

Your friends, family, bring a picnic, a blanket to sit on, chairs are welcome.

GETTING THERE

Where can I park?

There is parking onsite at Ningaloo Centre **however parking is limited.**

We encourage you to consider walking or riding bikes to the event.

SEATING

Where can I sit?

There are allocated areas for you to sit on blankets and other areas for high back chairs.

Where is the blanket area?

Towards the front of the gardens, near the stage, is the blanket/picnic rug area

Low deck chair seating and blanket seating is allowed throughout the park area.

Where is the high back chair area?

At the rear of the gardens is a high deck chair seating area.
