WHEN IS IT?

6.30pm Saturday 4 April 2020
Gates open from 5pm

WHERE IS IT?

The Pinnacles, Nambung National Park, Cervantes

DO I NEED A TICKET?

Yes. The concert is a paid ticketed event.

- You need to pre-book your ticket and your parking as there is a limited capacity.
- All patrons need to present tickets at the entry gate upon arrival.
- Please bring a hard copy or save to your digital device (internet access is intermittent).

Is there a program online?

continue with the performance please note that the quality of the sound may be affected. Please bring a raincoat if rain is forecast

Can I bring a picnic?

Yes. You are encouraged to bring a picnic inclusive of food, drinks and water. Open flames and candles are not permitted.

Can I bring a chair?

Yes. Low chairs and blankets are welcome. Seating is unreserved.

What do I wear?

Casual, comfortable clothing (e.g. jeans, t-shirt and shoes for walking on sandy and uneven terrain. The weather is cooler in the evening so we recommend bringing a jacket).

Can I buy food onsite?

The Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre will be open prior to the performance only. A small selection of drinks and snacks are available for purchase. You can also pre-book a picnic hamper from the Lobster Shack.

What do I bring?

Bring **a torch or download torch app on your phone**. We will be working within the natural landscape and beauty of The Pinnacles. Lighting within this iconic landscape is limited

GETTING THERE

How do I get there?

The Pinnacles is located in Nambung National Park, approximately 2 hours from Perth CBD. There are Shuttle Bus services departing Perth, Cervantes Visitors Centre and Jurien Bay. More details at <https://www.waopera.asn.au/shows/operatic-events>

Where can I park onsite?

Parking within the Pinnacles is very limited and car bays must be pre-booked at the time that you book your tickets <https://www.eventopia.co/event/Opera-in-the-Pinnacles/408833>

Can I park at Cervantes or Jurien bay and take the Shuttle Bus?

Shuttle buses will depart from, and return to, Cervantes Visitor Centre and Jurien Bay Visitors Centre. Bookings must be made in advance via <https://www.eventopia.co/event/Opera-in-the-Pinnacles/408833> There will be room on the buses to bring your picnic and low chairs.

Will there be accessible access if I can't walk far?

The performance location a 10-minute walk from the car park. For patrons requiring assistance a small shuttle will leave from the Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre to the performance space every 15 mins. Bookings are not required.

Can I be dropped off?

Yes, there will be a passenger drop point at the Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre.
