begins.



# TOILETS



If I need to go to the toilet, I can find them on every level by following the signs.



# USHERS



If I need help, I can approach the Ushers dressed in their black and red uniforms.



# GOING UPSTAIRS



To go upstairs into the dress circle or snack and drinks bar, I can use the lift or the stairs.



# FOOD AND DRINKS



Before the show, I can purchase food and drinks at the snack and drinks bar.



# FOOD AND DRINKS



I can bring into the theatre a drink bottle with a lid and snacks.



# ENTERING THE AUDITORIUM



I will show the  
usher my ticket  
before I can enter  
the auditorium.



# SEATS



When I enter the  
auditorium I can sit  
in any available  
seat.



# BOOSTER SEATS



If I need a booster seat I can pick one up after entering the auditorium.



# LIGHTS



When the show starts, the lights will darken a little.



# DOORS



The doors will remain open during the performance. If I need to leave, go to the toilet or the quiet area, I can do so.



# PACING AREA



I can pace at the  
back of the  
auditorium if I want  
to.



# QUIET AREA



I can go to the quiet area during the performance if I need to relax. It is on the first level. There are bean bags and art materials at the quiet area.



# LOUD NOISES



Sometimes the show can be loud. Audiences will also clap when the show ends. I can clap my hands or cover my ears if it is too loud.



# EXITING



When the show ends, I can follow the signs and leave through the exit doors.



# PARKING



The nearest ACROD parking is 290m away from the theatre.



# CARPARK

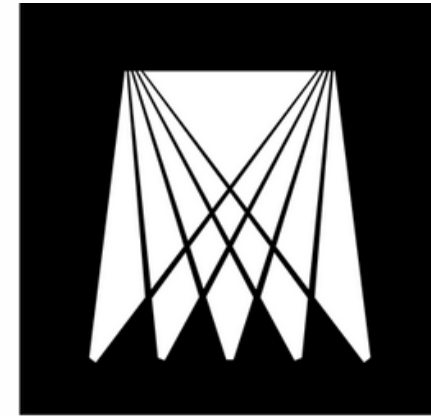


The nearest
