

When I get there, I will walk through the double doors.


BOOKING OFFICE






If I need to collect my tickets, I will collect them at the booking office.

ENTERING THE AUDITORIUM






I will show the usher my ticket before I can enter the auditorium.

SEATS




When I enter the auditorium I can sit in any available seat.






If I need a booster seat I can pick one up after entering the auditorium.

LGHTS




When the show starts, the lights will darken a little.

I can pace at the back of the auditorium if I want to.


OUIET AREA





I can go to the quiet area during the performance if I need to relax. It is on the first level. There are bean bags and art materials at the quiet area.


LOUD NOISES
